
#### Physical resources



Suggested improvements to equipment and facilities from caregivers include using IT in classrooms (19%), improving sports facilities (19%) and updating classrooms (19%). Teachers suggest updating classrooms (42%) and more computer rooms (24%).



## In summary

### Key findings

- Significant positive shifts in perception noted in 2009 has consolidated in 2014:
  - Respect for the Headmaster remained high (driving force behind the high performance of the school).
  - Strong sense of belonging remained, with a sense of pride in association with the school evident.
  - School values and culture remained highly regarded.
  - The structured management, review and implementation system remained well endorsed.
  - Clear expectations of teachers and students were evident and expected.
  - The school remained a well structured, safe and positive learning environment.

#### Points to consider

- Accommodating growth
  - Increased student roll.
  - Ongoing maintenance and communication around mid- to long-term plans for physical resources.
- Information Technology
  - Challenge to provide a traditional education through cutting edge technology.
  - Continue to include a component of modernisation in ongoing maintenance and upgrade and teaching resources.
- Opportunity to represent
  - Pride in school evident from teachers, caregivers and students.
