PLAN OF ACTION

1. Decide which **FOUR** camps you would like to go on, in **order of preference**, and then fill out the enrolment form. Should too many students have the same first choice camp then you must be prepared to go on either your second, third or fourth choice.
2. Return the enrolment form to 'THE SHOP' before 29th August. We endeavour to accommodate all students in a camp of their choice.
3. Camp lists will be placed on the B BLOCK noticeboard on 12th September. Camp leaders will then call meetings to give additional information - clothing and equipment lists, consent and health forms, confirmed final cost and payment details, programmes etc.
4. Refunds are not always possible to give, so please choose carefully.

AWAY CAMPS

ABEL TASMAN

COST: \$800.00

VENUE: Abel Tasman, South Island

TE UREWERA HUNTING CAMP

COST: \$325.00

STAFF: Mr Winslade, Mr Botting, Mr Bennett and one other adult

VENUE: Te Totara Hut surrounds, Te Urewera National Park

ACCOMMODATION: Tent and private hut

SPECIAL EQUIPMENT REQUIRED: A tent, a large pack and a good day pack, sleeping bag, good boots and other tramping gear.

ACTIVITIES: Are you keen on hunting and the outdoors? Then this is the camp for you. Te Urewera Hunting camp will take place in the Waiau Valley in Te Urewera national Park. Here there is excellent hunting for Deer and Pigs as well as trout fishing. This is a small camp and there is only room for 8 students with 4 adults (Mr Botting, Mr Bennett, Mr Winslade and one other). Hunting will be done in twos and threes (one or two students per adult) and we have a good chance of getting onto some pigs or deer. All the adults on this trip are experienced and safety conscious hunters who are passionate about our sport. Students will be staying in tents at the hut so you will need a tent (you can share with a mate), a large 75 litre capacity pack and a decent day pack. You will also need to carry your own food and have appropriate clothing and footwear. It will be strenuous at times, so you will need to have a good level of fitness to get up those hills. Remember numbers are limited so sign up quick. If you have any questions please feel free to talk to Mr Winslade in B4.



COROMANDEL GOLD

COST: \$185.00

ACTIVITIES: This is a 3 day camp which takes in a number of different Coromandel 'hot' spots. Surfing, surfing and more surfing is combined with various van challenges, snorkeling in marine reserves and good old kiwi bbqs and beach games with ya mates. If surfing and hanging at the beach giving all activities a decent crack sounds a bit of you, then this is the camp you need to select. The teachers are pumped up for this and you should be too!

NATIONAL PARK ADVENTURE

ACTIVITIES: This is a three day adventure camp. Are you up to the challenge? During the first day you will explore the underground amongst the glow worms on a black water tubing adventure. Then be prepared for a world famous all day tramp around Mt Tongariro. The last day includes white-water rafting on the Tongaririro River, before we head back to Hamilton.



SNAPPER SAFARI

VENUE: Charter Boat from Te Kouma Coromandel

ACCOMMODATION: Tents, Long Bay Motor Camp

ACTIVITIES: The charter boat takes us out of Te Kouma, Coromandel. Over the four days we target different species such as snapper and every student gets three trips – mussel farms, reefs and worm beds. Students will stay in tents (to be organised in groups) and be responsible for their own meals using the accommodation facilities. Training sessions will be given for rigs. Students need to supply their own rod(s), life jacket and tackle.

RANGITIKEI RIVER ADVENTURE

No prior experience with canoes necessary – professional guides will accompany us.

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ROWING FOR ROWERS



GAMING WORKSHOP


